
Octopus

Octopuses are sea animals famous for their rounded bodies, bulging eyes and eight long arms. Like their cousin, the squid, if threatened, octopuses shoot an inky fluid from their body that darkens the water around them, confusing the aggressor.





They can also hide and blend in with their surroundings, too, by changing colour to grey, brown, pink, blue or green. As well as for camouflage, these incredible invertebrates use colour change as a way to communicate with other octopuses.
