Backyard Chickens

Raising chickens at home for their eggs is becoming popular in North American cities. This is the result of increasing public concern about industrial egg production and a greater awareness of the benefits of natural, chemical-free foods. Many cities have now passed laws that allow homeowners to keep chickens for household egg production. People who keep chickens say startup costs can be high, but the eggs are cheaper than store-bought ones in the long run. Moreover, they argue that keeping chickens at home helps reduce the CO2 caused by commercial egg production and distribution.

Some city residents, however, object to having chickens in their neighborhood. They say chicken feed attracts rats and mice, and that predators from the wild may appear, which could endanger pets such as cats and small dogs. Other residents also complain that chickens are noisy, and that they create an unpleasant smell.
