
7:00 It's seven o'clock. It's seven p.m. / a.m.

9:15 It's nine fifteen. It's (a) quarter after nine.


It's ten (minutes) after three.

4:50 It's four fifty. It's ten minutes to five.



8:35 It's eight thirty-five. It's twenty-five minutes to nine.
