Most laypeople assume that when human brain cells die, they are gone forever. In the past decade, however, neurologists have determined that brain-cell regeneration, or neurogenesis, does occur. What's more, preliminary studies on rats suggest there may be a positive correlation between the ability to deal with cognitive challenges and brain-cell regeneration. By further analyzing how neurogenesis happens, neurologists hope to unlock ways to regenerate cells in people who have suffered brain injuries or have brain disorders.
