dot (in this case - verb)

- to spread things or people over an area; to be spread over an area ex.A lot of bars and cafes dot the street.

bustle (verb)

- to move around in a busy way or to hurry ex. The city center is bustling with activity.

bolster (verb)

- to improve something or make it stronger ex.Please try to bolster her confidence before the exam.

launchpad (noun)

- (figurative meaning) an effective starting point for a career, enterprise, or campaign ex.He views this job as a launchpad for his future political career.

savvy (adjective)

– having practical knowledge or understanding of something ex. John is the most business savvy person I know.

afloat (adjective)

- (of a business, etc.) having enough money to pay debts; able to survive ex. They need to fire 28 employees to cut costs and manage to stay afloat.
