- When you paraphrase a sentence or group of sentences, look for the most important points.

## POINTS TO REMEMBER IN PARAPHRASING

- > Always use your own words and your own sentence structure.
- Write in a style that is natural to you.
- \*o not change the essential nature of what the writer is saying it is the writer's point of view that you are writing about.

Although you need not put quotation marks around a paraphrased passage, you **ust** give a citation in the appropriate form.
