

Million-dollar Trial Aborted on Account of Sudoku

June 11, 2008 – A drug trial in Sydney, Australia was aborted yesterday after several jurors were found to be playing sudoku puzzles during proceedings.

The trial, in which Andrew Daniel Lonsdale and Kane Holland were accused of conspiracy to manufacture a commercial quantity of amphetamines, had been running for over three months, involved 105 witnesses and cost over A\$1 million, and was scheduled to end soon with both parties prepared to deliver final statements this week.
