-the strength or force that allows something to continue or to grow stronger or faster as time passes

Example: Their fight for freedom gains momentum with every passing day.

strenuously

- -The adverb strenuously is good for describing activities or actions that require hard work.
- -When you do something strenuously, you work really hard at it

Example: He is strenuously resisting the new policies.

discredit

- -damage the reputation of
- -Discredit means to cause mistrust or cast the accuracy of something into doubt.

Example: His theories are nowadays discredited by the majority of physicists.

Example: This newspaper story discredits the politicians.

fly in the face of (someone or something) - idiom

- to go against someone or something.

Example: His proposed course of action flies in the face of everything that we stand for.
