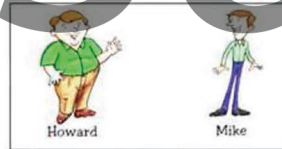

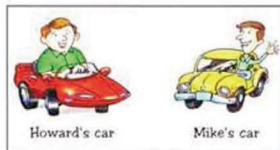

 She usually washes it on Saturday.

 Does your girlfriend usually jog in the evening?
 No, she sometimes jogs in the evening. She usually jogs in the afternoon.

6
 Does your neighbor's dog always bark during the night?
 No, he never barks during the night. He usually barks at night.
