

Blending

What are blends?

A blend, in morphology, is a word formed from parts of two or more words. In this sense blending is a process, among other processes, of creating new words.

Examples:

- brunch = breakfast + lunch
- Breathalyzer = breath + analyzer
- camcorder = camera + recorder
- emoticon = emote + icon
- motel = motor car + hotel
- Globish = global + English
- sitcom = situation + comedy
- smog = smoke + fog
- Spork = spoon + fork
- workaholic = work + alcoholic

Activities :

Encourage the students to make blends whether formal or informal that they can use in formal and informal conversations. Blending is getting popular in other parts of the world especially to those English speaking countries.
