VOCABULARY:

get something off the ground

(idiom) – (in this case) if an idea or activity gets off the ground, it means it starts or succeeds

Example: When my business finally gets off the ground, I will consider hiring more people.

interfere (verb) – to get involved in and try to influence a situation that does not concern you, in a way that annoys other people

Example: Don't interfere too much in your son's life. Let him make his own decisions.

radius (noun) – a round area that covers the distance mentioned from a central point Example: There are no open stores on Sunday on a two kilometer radius of my house.

traceable (adjective) – if something is traceable, you can find out where it came from, where it has gone, when it began or what its cause was Example: Almost all phone calls are traceable.
