Vocabulary:

express

-to show a feeling or opinion or to make it known

Example: They're not very good at expressing their opinion.

pictograph

-a picture that represents a word or a phrase

Example: What's the meaning of the pictograph you sent me?

informally

-not in an official way

Example: I will dress informally for lunch with my coworkers.

squad

-a group of people with a particular task

Example: The small squad of soldiers crossed the border at midnight.

English Owes Much to Japanese Words

In the past several hundred years, English has borrowed words and terms from other languages, including Japanese.

In the late 1990s, Japanese computer programmer Shigetaku Kurita invented "emoji" - images, icons and symbols that express meaning without words.
