Pronunciation is the way in which a word or letter is said, or said correctly, or the way in which a language is spoken.

❖ Set 1

can cane
cap cape
gab Gabe
sat sate

cane (noun) = a stick that people can lean on to help them walk

cape = a sleeveless garment like a cloak but shorter

Example: Superman is easily recognizable by his red cape.

gab = to talk a lot in an informal way usually about things that are not important

sate (verb) = fill to satisfaction

Sometimes you're so hungry you feel like you could eat a ten-course meal. Other times it takes just a small salad to sate your appetite, or to satisfy your hunger.

Example: I am sated.
