Pronunciation is the way in which a word or letter is said, or said correctly, or the way in which a language is spoken.

Set 1can canecap capegab Gabesat sate

cane (noun) = a stick that people can lean on to help them walk
cape = a sleeveless garment like a cloak but shorter

**Example:** Superman is easily recognizable by his red cape.

**gab** = to talk a lot in an informal way usually about things that are not important **sate** (verb) = fill to satisfaction

Sometimes you're so hungry you feel like you could eat a ten-course meal. Other times it takes just a small salad to sate your appetite, or to satisfy your hunger.

**Example:** I am sated.
